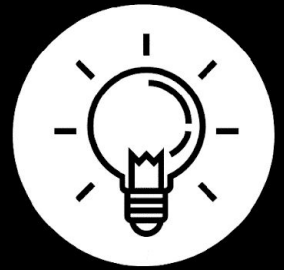


Miss Boornazian's Class News

Last week, we spent time continuing to work on growth mindset as well as reviewing the expectations in school. Students began Homeworkopoly and are motivated to play!

We started our math unit on place value and did a review on whole numbers. Jiji was set up on iPads and students are having fun completing puzzles. Students were introduced to the Scientific Method and in writing, began to come up with ideas to recreate popular stories and fairytales.

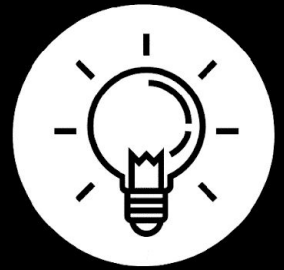
